# INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REVIEW REPORT ON THE INTERIM CONDENSED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS To the Unitholders of Alinma Emerging Markets Fund (Managed by Alinma Capital Company)

### Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying interim condensed statement of financial position of Alinma Emerging Markets Fund ("the Fund") being managed by Alinma Capital Company ( the "Fund Manager") as at 30 June 2025, and the related interim condensed statements of profit or loss and other comprehensive income, cash flows and changes in equity for the six-month period then ended, including other explanatory notes. The Fund Manager is responsible for the preparation and presentation of these interim condensed financial statements in accordance with International Accounting Standard 34 — "Interim Financial Reporting ("IAS 34")" that is endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on these interim condensed financial statements based on our review.

### Scope of review

We conducted our review in accordance with International Standard on Review Engagements 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity" that is endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. A review of the interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with International Standards on Auditing that are endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

### Conclusion

Based on our review, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying interim condensed financial statements are not prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with IAS 34, that is endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

# NOTES TO THE INTERIM CONDENSED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS 30 June 2025

### 1 INCORPORATION AND ACTIVITIES

Alinma Emerging Markets Fund, (the "Fund"), is an open-ended Shariah compliant fund created under an agreement between Alinma Capital Company (the "Fund Manager"), a subsidiary of Alinma Bank (the "Bank") and investors (the "Unitholders") in the Fund, in accordance with Capital Market Authority ("CMA") regulations.

The objective of the Fund is to achieve long term capital growth through investing in emerging market equities approved by the Fund's Shariah Supervisory Committee.

The CMA granted approval for the establishment of the Fund on 14 Dhul-Hijjah 1445H (corresponding to 2 July 2023). The Fund commenced its operations on 29 Safar 1445H (corresponding to 14 September 2023). Accordingly, the first financial period of the Fund covers the period from 14 September 2023 to 31 December 2024, and hence, the comparative information of the interim condensed statements of profit or loss and other comprehensive income, cashflows and changes in equity covers the period from 14 September 2023 to 30 June 2024.

The Fund is managed by Alinma Capital Company (the "Fund Manager"), a closed joint stock company with commercial registration number 1010269764, licensed by the Capital Market Authority of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia ("CMA") under license number 09134-37.

The Fund Manager is responsible for the overall management of the Fund's activities. The Fund Manager can also enter into arrangements with other institutions for the provision of investment, custody or other administrative services on behalf of the Fund.

The Fund has appointed Northern Trust Company of Saudi Arabia (the "Custodian") to act as its custodian. The fees of the custodian are paid by the Fund.

# 2 REGULATING AUTHORITY

The Fund is governed by the Investment Fund Regulations (the "Regulations") issued by the CMA detailing requirements for all investment funds within the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

# 3 BASIS OF PREPARATION

# 3.1 Statement of compliance

These interim condensed financial statements for the six-month period ended 30 June 2025 of the Fund have been prepared in accordance with International Accounting Standard 34 – Interim Financial Reporting ("IAS 34") as endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and other standards and pronouncements that are endorsed by Saudi Organisation for Chartered and Professional Accountants ("SOCPA").

The Fund Manager has prepared the interim condensed financial statements on the basis that the Fund will continue to operate as a going concern. The Fund Manager considers that there are no material uncertainties that may cast significant doubt over this assumption. They have formed a judgement that there is a reasonable expectation that the Fund has adequate resources to continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future, and not less than 12 months from the end of the reporting period.

The interim condensed financial statements do not include all information and disclosures required in the annual financial statements and should be read in conjunction with the Fund's annual financial statements as at 31 December 2024.

# 3.2 Basis of measurement

These interim condensed financial statements have been prepared under historical cost convention, except for the financial assets at FVTPL which are measured at fair value.

The interim condensed statement of financial position is stated broadly in order of liquidity. All assets and liabilities are current in nature.

# 3.3 Functional and presentation currency

These interim condensed financial statements are presented in Saudi Riyal (SR), which is also the functional currency of the Fund. All financial information has been rounded off to the nearest SR, unless otherwise stated

# 3.4 Use of judgements, estimates and assumptions

In preparing these interim condensed financial statements, the Fund Manager has made the judgement, estimates, and assumptions that affect the application of the Fund's accounting policies and the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, income and expenses. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

The significant judgments made by the Fund Manager in applying the Fund's accounting policies and the key sources of estimation uncertainty were the same as those described in the last annual audited financial statements.

# 4 MATERIAL ACCOUNTING POLICY INFORMATION

The accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the interim condensed financial statements are consistent with those followed in the preparation of the Fund's annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2024 except for the adoption of new amendments to existing standards effective as of 1 January 2025. Certain amendments apply for the first time in 2025, but do not have an impact on the interim condensed financial statements of the Fund.

### 6 TRANSACTIONS AND BALANCES WITH REPLATED PARTY

In the ordinary course of activities, the Fund transacts business with related parties. The related party transactions are governed by limit set by the terms and conditions. All related party transactions are disclosed to the Fund Board of Director.

Related parties of the Fund include the Fund Manager, the Bank, entities related to the Bank and the Fund Manager and any party that has the ability to control other party or exercise significant influence over the party in making financial or operational decisions.

# a) Management fees

The Fund Manager is responsible for the overall management of the Fund's activities. The Fund Manager charges management fee at the rate of 1.75% of the Fund's assets.

# b) Brokerage expense

The Fund Manager charges 0.0015% brokerage fees on the purchase and sales transactions of financial assets at FVTPL.

# c) Board of Directors remuneration

The Board of Directors are allowed maximum remuneration of SR 24,000 for all board members in one year. During the period, Board remuneration was charged amounting to SR 5,918 (30 June 2024: SR 18,123).

Management believes that the fair value of all other financial assets and liabilities are at the reporting date approximate their carrying values owing to their short-term tenure and the fact that these are readily liquid. These are all classified within level 2 of the fair value hierarchy. There were no transfers between the various levels of fair value hierarchy during the current period.
